OUR LASER TREATMENTS

Hunter Laser Centre is dedicated to providing state of the art laser treatments for a variety of medical conditions.

INITIAL ASSESSMENT

An initial consultation is required for all potential patients to assess their suitability for laser treatment.

This consultation costs \$100 (\$70 can be refunded through Medicare).

ANTI-SNORING TREATMENT

Snoring not only ruins your quality of sleep, it can be irritating for your partner. It is caused by a partial blockage by lax tissues at the back of your throat when you sleep.

We treat snoring with the NightLase™ laser

This laser is designed to strengthen tissue in your throat so that it doesn't become lax. After treatment, most patients find that they have effective relief from both snoring and symptoms of obstructive sleep apnoea. Many patients also report that the treatment improves halitosis (bad breath).

Three treatment sessions are recommended.

URINARY INCONTINENCE TREATMENT

What is LBL?

LBL (Light bladder leakage), a type of urinary incontinence or leaky bladder, is an embarrassing and uncomfortable condition for many women. Leakage of urine can be triggered by a number of things including stress, coughing or sneezing and physical exertion such as lifting.

What causes LBL?

There are many different causes of LBL including:

- Stress incontinence
- Childbirth (becomes more likely with more children)
- Weak pelvic floor muscles
- Vaginal atrophy (a natural consequence of aging)

How does IncontiLase™ work?

The laser shrinks and tightens the tissue in your anterior vaginal and periurethral areas. This in turn provides better support for your urethra. Much of the treatment is performed inside the vagina with a special laser device. Your doctor will make you feel comfortable throughout this procedure.

Don't be afraid to talk about LBL

LBL is a common problem which affects up to 1 in 3 women. Our doctors have specific skills in treating LBL. Please don't feel nervous or embarrassed when asking about this procedure as we are here to help.

VAGINAL PROLAPSE

Vaginal prolapse is a condition in which pelvic organs (uterus, bladder or rectum) slip down from their normal position. Prolapse is often associated with other problems such as urinary incontinence.

Prolapse can be graded by how far the organs have slipped. Most cases of prolapse are relatively mild and can be completely corrected by the ProlapLase™ procedure. Even higher grades of prolapse can be significantly improved.

VAGINAL TIGHTENING TREATMENT

Vaginal laxity occurs as a natural consequence of aging and menopause (vaginal atrophy), and can be particularly pronounced after childbirth. The unwanted effects of this include:

- A lack of sexual gratification for both you and your partner
- Dryness and itchiness
- Incontinence or LBL

The IntimaLase™ Laser Procedure

Laser light is applied to the walls of the vagina. It penetrates the mucosal tissue which will then tighten. The result often improves over the following six months as collagen tissue is restored.
